



**Thirtieth Sunday in Ordinary Time,
October 24th**

Dear Brothers and Sisters,

This week, as we end the month of the Rosary and begin the month of November, we begin with two important celebration that help define the identity of the Church. Next Monday, November 1st, the Solemnity of All Saints, is usually a Holy Day of Obligation; this year, however, is not a Holy Day of Obligation because it falls on a Monday, and the U.S. Bishops have decided it is too demanding on you to attend Holy Mass two days in a row as an obligation. This is a celebration of the Triumph of Christ. Through the Passion, Death, and Resurrection of the Lord the gates of Heaven were opened, and so too, the flood gates of God's mercy. With this Solemnity, the One, Holy, Catholic and Apostolic Church celebrates who she is as the "Communion of Saints." As the Catechism teaches, "*We believe in the communion of all the faithful of Christ, those who are pilgrims on earth, the dead who are being purified, and the blessed in heaven, all together forming the Church; and we believe that in this communion, the merciful love of God and his saints are always attentive to our prayers*" (#962).

On Monday, November 1st, the two Mass we will celebrate the blessed in heaven, the "*Church Triumphant.*" This part of the Church is made up of all those who are already enjoying the Beatific Vision. Mary, the mother of Jesus, Saints Peter, Mary Magdalene, Maria Goretti, Monica, Augustine, Faustina, John Paul II, etc. . . , and perhaps some who you may have known personally during your life time, who have already arrived to their eternal reward. The following day, Tuesday, November 2, and for the rest of the month of November, we will be praying for, and remembering the dead who are being purified; these are the souls in purgatory, the "*Church Suffering.*" This is a joyful suffering in anticipation of seeing God face to face. The reality is that most, at the moment of death still have some residue of sin and need to be purified by the Blood of the Lamb shed for us on the cross. Purgatory is the anti-chamber of heaven, or, the laundry room, where our white baptismal garment is washed clean so that we can be dressed appropriately for the heavenly banquet feast. Since Old Testament times it has been a pious tradition and an act of charity to pray for the dead. These souls cannot pray for themselves and so need our prayers. We, those who are pilgrims on earth, are the "*Church Militant,*" fighting the good fight as Saint Paul says. We are part of the "*Communion of Saints,*" gathered together singing "*Sanctus, Sanctus, Sanctus Dominus Deus Sabaoth.*" "Holy, Holy, Holy Lord, God of Hosts." As we approach All Souls Day, please be aware that there will be a coffin in our outdoor church. This is a cultural tradition in many parts of the world. This is a reminder to us of those who have died and are still in need of our prayers.

By now you should have received your monthly donation envelops, among which you will find the one for All Souls Day. There is space on the envelop for you to write the names of your beloved dead that you wish for me to remember in the Holy Masses that will be celebrated throughout the month of November. I will keep these names at the altar for the entire month. I also ask that each of you, in your charity, to not only remember your own loved ones in your prayers, but all who have died.

**Trigésimo Domingo del Tiempo
Ordinario, Octubre 24**

Queridos Hermanos y Hermanas,

Esta semana, como terminamos el mes del Rosario y empezamos el mes de Noviembre, comenzamos con dos celebraciones importantes que ayudan a definir la identidad de la Iglesia. El próximo lunes, Noviembre 1, La Solemnidad de todos los Santos, suele ser un Día Santo de Obligación; este año, sin embargo, no es un Día Santo de Obligación porque cae en lunes, y los obispos de los Estados Unidos han decidido que es demasiado exigente para usted asistir a la Santa Misa dos días seguidos como una obligación. Esta es una celebración del Triunfo de Cristo. A través de la pasión, Muerte y Resurrección del Señor se abrieron las puertas del Cielo, y también, las puertas de la misericordia de Dios. Con esta solemnidad, la Una, Santa, Católica y Apostólica Iglesia celebra quién es ella como la "Comunión de los Santos" Como enseña el Catecismo, "*Creemos en la comunión de todos los fieles de Cristo, los que son peregrinos en la tierra, los muertos que están siendo purificados, y los bienaventurados en el cielo, todos juntos formando la Iglesia; y creemos que en esta comunión, el amor misericordioso de Dios y sus santos están siempre atentos a nuestras oraciones*" (962). El lunes, 1^{er} de Noviembre, las dos misas celebraremos a los bienaventurados en el cielo, la "*Iglesia Triunfante.*" Esta parte de la Iglesia está formada por todos aquellos que ya están disfrutando de la Visión Beatífica. María, madre de Jesus, San Pedro, María Magdalena, María Goretti, Mónica, Agustín, Faustina, Juan Pablo II, etc. . . y tal vez algunos a quienes puede haber conocido personalmente durante su vida, que ya han llegado a su recompensa eterna. Al día siguiente, Martes, 2 de Noviembre, y por el resto del mes de Noviembre, estaremos orando por, y recordando, los muertos que están siendo purificados; estas son las almas en el purgatorio, la "*Iglesia Purgante.*" Este es un sufrimiento gozoso en anticipación de ver a Dios cara a cara. La realidad es que la mayoría, en el momento de la muerte todavía tenemos algún residuo de pecado y necesitan ser purificados por la Sangre del Cordero derramada por nosotros en la cruz. El purgatorio es la antecámara del cielo, o el cuarto de lavado, donde nuestra vestimenta bautismal blanca se lava limpia para que podamos vestirnos apropiadamente para la fiesta del banquete celestial. Desde los tiempos del Antiguo Testamento ha sido una tradición piadosa y un acto de caridad orar por los muertos. Estas almas no pueden orar por sí mismas y, por lo tanto, necesitan nuestras oraciones. Nosotros, los que somos peregrinos en la tierra, somos "*La Iglesia Militante,*" peleando la buena batalla como dice San Pablo. Somos parte de la "*Comunión de los Santos,*" reunidos juntos cantando "*Sanctus, Sanctus, Sanctus Dominus Deus Sabaoth.*" "Santo, Santo, Santo Señor, Dios de los Ejércitos." A medida que nos acercamos al Día de los Fieles Difuntos tenga en cuenta que habrá un ataúd en nuestra iglesia al aire libre. Esta es una tradición cultural en muchas partes del mundo. Este es un recordatorio para nosotros de aquellos que han muerto y todavía necesitan nuestras oraciones. A estas alturas ya deberías haber recibido tus sobres de donación mensual, entre los que encontrarás el del Día de Fieles Difuntos. Hay espacio en el sobre para que escribas los nombres de tus amados muertos que deseas que recuerde en las Santas Misas que se celebrarán durante todo el mes de Noviembre. Mantendré estos nombres en el altar durante todo el mes. También les pido a cada uno de ustedes, en su caridad, no solo recordar a sus propios seres queridos en sus oraciones, pero también a todos los que han muerto.






