Second Sunday In Ordinary Time.
January 16TH

Dear Brothers and Sisters,

Last Sunday we concluded the Christmas Season and on Monday, we entered into the Ordinary Season of the Church Year. Recall that the year, as the Church lives it, follows the life of Jesus. Each year we are able to reflect in a new way about our relationship with Jesus and His Church. Recall that we began Cycle C of the three year cycle, A, B, and now we are in year C. This particular year, the theme of "Epiphany" is prolonged.

"Epiphany" means *manifestation, made know, or revealed*. The first was the star that appeared in the heavens and lead the wise men to Bethlehem, where they found God in flesh. The second was at the Baptism of the Lord, when the voice of God the Father revealed the identity of Jesus, "You are my beloved Son." Today is the third "Epiphany" as Jesus, prompted by His mother, Mary, performs His first miracle, changing water into wine. And His disciples believed in Him. Wine is the drink of celebration and lifts the spirits. It was a celebratory drink for weddings. The image of wine is the image of the Blood of Christ poured out on the cross. The grape must give up its life; shed its blood if you will, its juice, in order for wine to be made. Wine, which Jesus took at the Last Supper and said, "*This is the chalice of my blood, which will be shed for many for the forgiveness of sins.*" We hear these words every Sunday, and everyday, as Holy Mass is celebrated. "*This is the chalice of my blood.*" The Holy Spirit is called down upon the bread and the wine. Before we receive Holy Communion, we are presented with the effects of the consecration of the bread and wine – "that they may become for us the Body and Blood of our Lord, Jesus Christ." God has come close to us in the incarnation, being born of the Blessed Virgin Mary and laid in a manger. But to look upon the infant, we know who He is. He who was placed in a feeding trough for animals, He who was born in the City of Bread, Bethlehem, He who is the Living Bread come down from heaven, is presented to us to take and consume into our body so that we may be absorbed into Him, His life. "The Lamb of God" is to say He was slaughtered for us, for our offenses, so that we might be forgiven of our sins and not suffer eternal death. The lamb's blood was the sign for the Angel of Death in Exodus at the first Passover, that life would be saved. It is the Blood of the Lamb of God, Jesus, that saves our life from eternal death so that we would be saved. In John's Gospel Jesus says, "*Unless you eat the flesh of the Son of Man and drink his blood, you do not have life within you. Whoever eats my flesh and drinks my blood has eternal life, and I will raise him on the last day.*" Just as we need blood pumped through our body to live, we need the Blood of Jesus in our body so that we will live for eternal life. This could only happen if by His blood we are saved and our sins forgiven. This is how and why sins can be forgiven in the confessional. We must be willing to come close to the gift that has first come close to us, Jesus Christ, who does not want a sinner to be lost, but to be saved. It is indeed a very humbling experience to "Behold" Jesus as we are invited to come close and consume the gift He is for us. The one who receives this gift must be ready to live the very life that we take in and are absorbed into. For this is the reason that He came, that we would be counted as His brothers and sisters and become children of God.

Segundo Domingo Del Tiempo Ordinario.
Enero 16

Queridos Hermanos y Hermanas,

El pasado domingo concluimos el tiempo navideño y el lunes, entramos en el Tiempo Ordinario del Año de la Iglesia. Recordemos que el año, como la Iglesia lo vive, sigue la vida de Jesús. Cada año somos capaces de reflexionar de una manera nueva acerca de nuestra relación con Jesús y Su Iglesia. Recordemos que iniciamos el Ciclo C del ciclo de tres años, A, B, ahora estamos en el año C. Este año en particular, el tema de "epifanía" es prolongada. "Epifanía" significa *manifestación, se a hecho saber, revelado*. La primera fue la estrella que apareció en los cielos y llevó a los sabios a Belén. donde encontraron a Dios en carne. El segundo fue en el Bautismo del Señor, cuando la voz de Dios Padre reveló la identidad de Jesús. "Tú eres mi Hijo Amado." Hoy es la tercer "Epifanía" al Jesús ser impulsado por Su madre, María, realiza su primer milagro, transformando el agua en vino. Y Sus discípulos creyeron en Él. El vino es la bebida de celebración y levanta el ánimo. Era una bebida de celebración para bodas. La imagen del vino es la imagen de la Sangre de Cristo derramada en la cruz. El mosto de uva renuncia a su vida; derrama su sangre si quieres, su jugo, para que se elabore el vino. Vino, que Jesús tomó en la Última Cena y dijo, "*Este es el cáliz de mi sangre, que será derramado por muchos para el perdón de los pecados.*"

Escuchamos estas palabras todos los domingos, y todos los días, al celebrarse la Santa Misa. "*Este es el cáliz de mi sangre,*" El Espíritu Santo es llamado sobre el pan y el vino. Antes de recibir la Sagrada Comunión, se nos presentan los efectos de la consagración del pan y del vino- "para que se conviertan para nosotros en el Cuerpo y la Sangre de nuestro Señor, Jesucristo." Dios se ha acercado a nosotros en la encarnación, siendo nacido de la Santísima Virgen María y puesto en un pesebre. Pero al mirar al bebé, sabemos quién es Él. El que fue colocado en un comedero para animales, El que nació en la Ciudad del Pan, Belén, Él que es el Pan Vivo desciende del cielo, se nos presenta para tomar y consumir en nuestro cuerpo para que podamos ser absorbidos por Él, Su Vida" El Cordero de Dios" es decir que fue sacrificado por nosotros, por nuestras ofensas, para que podamos ser perdonados de nuestros pecados y no sufrir la muerte eterna. La sangre del cordero fue la señal para el Ángel de la Muerte en Éxodo en la primera Pascua, que la vida se salvaría. Es la Sangre del Cordero de Dios, Jesús, que salva nuestra vida de la muerte eterna para que seamos salvos. En el Evangelio de Juan Jesús dice, "*A menos que comas la carne del Hijo del Hombre y bebas su sangre. no tienes vida dentro de ti. Quien come mi carne y bebe mi sangre tiene vida eterna, y lo resucitaré el último día.*" Así como necesitamos sangre bombeada a través de nuestro cuerpo para vivir, necesitamos la Sangre de Jesús en nuestro cuerpo para vivir para la vida eterna. Esto sólo podría suceder si por Su sangre somos salvos y nuestros pecados perdonados. Así es como y por qué los pecados pueden ser perdonados en el confesionario. Debemos estar dispuestos a acercarnos al don que primero se ha acercado a nosotros. Jesucristo, que no quiere que se pierda un pecador, sino para ser salvo. De hecho, es una experiencia muy humilde al "Contemplar" a Jesús al ser invitados a acercarnos y consumir el regalo que Él es para nosotros. El que recibe este regalo debe estar listo para vivir la misma vida que tomamos y en la que estamos absorbidos. Porque esta es la razón por la que Él vino, que seremos contados como Sus hermanos y hermanas y nos convertiríamos en hijos de Dios.

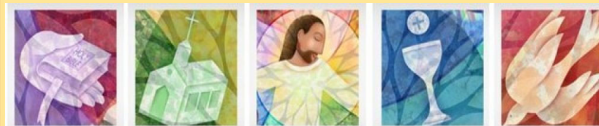
